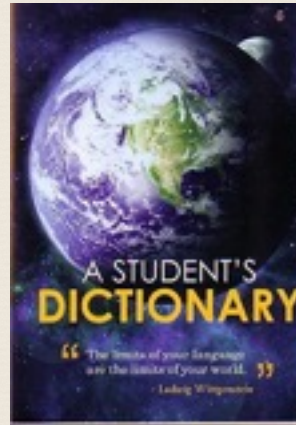

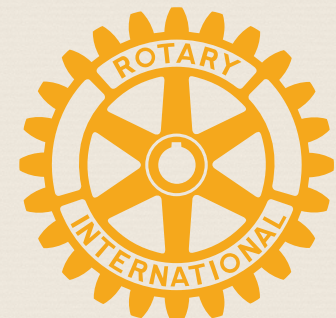
What is Rotary?

The Dictionary project provides every 3rd grader with a special dictionary. In addition to the traditional uses, the students dictionary includes additional resources that are utilized by teachers throughout the school year to help deliver history, science, and math lessons.



The goal of this program is to assist local students at becoming good writers, active readers, creative thinkers, and resourceful learners by providing them with their very own personal dictionary. The dictionaries are a gift to each 3rd grade student to use at school and at home for years to come. Educators see third grade as the dividing line between learning to read and reading to learn, so we encourage our donors and sponsors to help with a 100% tax deductible donation to help a school. All of the local third grade teachers were surveyed and the following results were found:

84% of the teachers agreed that the dictionaries are very useful and were often employed in literacy lessons.

74% agreed the dictionaries are useful across the entire curriculum.

62% agreed that there is evidence that the dictionaries are used at home.

Teachers also indicated that local students had only a 15-50% access to a computer at home.
